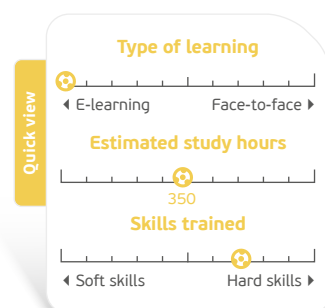

Programme overview

Application process

To apply for the UEFA CFM, complete the online application form available at UEFAacademy.com and submit it along with a CV, a short personal video and an electronic passport-sized photo.

The video should be no longer than three minutes. It should introduce you and your background, including previous football experience and qualifications, together with your motivation for applying. Please note, the video does not need to be of professional quality and can be filmed using a phone or computer.
