01 SEMINAR 1 FOOTBALL GOVERNANCE AND SPORTING STRATEGIES

22-24 March 2027, UK

To lead a football club effectively, sporting directors must master football governance and develop robust sporting strategies that ensure long-term success. Sporting directors are responsible for shaping their clubs' football philosophy, balancing short-term performance with long-term planning. This means aligning recruitment, player development and first-team goals with the broader vision of the club.
