

The SFC aims to equip those responsible for social and environmental sustainability within football organisations with the essential knowledge, practical tools and soft skills needed to enhance and drive sustainable practices at all levels of the game.



Programme overview

The Sustainability in Football Compact Course (SFC) is designed to empower sustainability managers in football organisations by enhancing their skills and knowledge of the topic. Engage in interactive workshops and presentations led by industry experts and academics, covering key topics such as sustainability fundamentals, social issues, environmental impact, policy, and effective monitoring and reporting. Aquire the tools and strategies you need to navigate challenges, secure buy-in from stakeholders and drive meaningful change.

Developed in partnership with the European Club Association (ECA) and SDA Bocconi, this course delivers the highest quality content with a long-lasting impact for both national associations and clubs, while also providing invaluable academic credibility.

Over four days at the SDA Bocconi campus in Milan, you will develop your own sustainability action plan to drive sustainability within your football organisation. By integrating insights and expertise from both inside and outside the football industry, you will gain a comprehensive understanding of the latest trends and best practices.

While the course is intended for sustainability managers at national associations and clubs, it is also open to professionals coming from other key stakeholders such as leagues and other confederations.

DAY1 CREATING A SUSTAINABILITY VISION AND BUILDING YOUR FOUNDATIONS

You will learn how to craft sustainability action plans focused on risk mitigation and innovation, and develop the skills - through interactive sessions - to drive cultural transformation for lasting impact.

DAY2

TACKLING EMISSIONS, THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY AND SUSTAINABLE EVENTS

Key topics will include how to reduce carbon footprints by examining emission sources and setting measurable targets aligned with global climate goals. Moreover, best practice examples and insights from leading experts will enhance your understanding of circular economy principles, as well as how to operate sustainable events and infrastructure.

DAY3 PROTECTING AND RESPECTING HUMAN RIGHTS

You will learn about human rights principles to ensure a safe, respectful environment, including policies to protect children, young adults and other and vulnerable groups. Learn how to create an inclusive culture by implementing robust DEI initiatives.

DAY4

MEASURING AND REPORTING SUSTAINABILITY

You will gain a deeper understanding about regulations impacting sustainability reporting in football and conduct materiality assessments to prioritise key issues for stakeholders. Data and KPIs will be leveraged to drive continuous improvement and communicate sustainability impacts. The course will conclude with a graduation ceremony.
